## Addendum to Grand Rapids Shelter information 07/2021

- Due to the continued increase and need for family shelter in our community, Mel Trotter, Family Promise and Degage have come together to partner in meeting this immediate need. Part of the solution is to open back up the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of women's shelter at Mel Trotter Ministry. to bring back families into this space. As of 07/09/2021, and until further notice all single emergency shelter women will now be housed at Degage. Check in time and process is as follows:
  - Please instruct women calling for shelter to come to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Life Enrichment Center at Degage Ministries between the hours of 8am- 3pm Monday –Thursday and 8am-1pm on Friday. An appointment will be made at that time for an intake.
  - Emergency intakes will be allowed if the patron is unable to schedule an intake during the times above. We ask that these women ring the buzzer at Degage's Cherry St entrance after 3pm and one of the Open Door Staff will be of assistance. This does include weekends and holidays.
